## Speech & Language Pathologist Aboriginal Head Start – Two Edmonton Site Locations Private Contract Position

The Aboriginal Head Start program is an Early Intervention Preschool program working specifically with First Nation, Inuit and Metis Preschoolers in their first educational setting. We provide services to Aboriginal children ages 3 ½ – 5 years of age who are identified as having a special or challenging need to function regularly in a classroom setting.

Funding for the program is provided by both the Public Health Agency of Canada along with Alberta Education who supports our Program Unit Funding (PUF) and Mild/Moderate (M/M) funded children. The children are supported by a dynamic multidisciplinary team consisting of a classroom teacher, educational assistants, Family Support Workers, Program Management, Home Educator, IPP Coordinator and Therapists (SLP's, OT's, CASA and Alberta Health Services).

Aboriginal Head Start is seeking an experienced part-time Speech-Language Pathologist (15 hours per week) to work collaboratively with designated Head Start teams and other contracted therapists in the program to provide assessment, consultations and intervention for our preschool kiddos between 2 classroom site locations in the city of Edmonton.

- Experience with Pre-School Aged children
- Experience with Aboriginal Culture and Traditions would be an asset
- Own transportation to travel between sites
